PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Heart Ministry Center's Fresh Start Job Training Program provides participants intensive job training and case management while operating Nebraska's largest food pantry.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- 9-month program
- Up to 40 hours per week (Monday-Saturday)
- Up to 20 participants at a time
- Financial assistance provided
- Post graduation case management with emphasis on:
 - Earned income and the balancing of a household budget
- Stable housing
- Reliable transportation
- Job retention

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Weekly meeting with mental health therapist
- Weekly group therapy
- Medical screening and comprehensive health plan
- Weekly exercise with certified nutritionist and personal trainer
- Financial literacy instruction
- Digital literacy program
- Weekly guided yoga and meditation classes
- Weekly meetings with case manager to discuss:
- Food
- Clothina
- Housing
- Transportation
- Cash flow
- Individual goals



























MEASURING PROGRAM SUCCESS

- Six months of employment that balances household budget, stable housing, and reliable transportation.
- Increased earning potential
- Progress with the barriers that created a need for the program
